If my device or electrical toy smells funny, gets hot or makes strange noises, I let a grown up know.

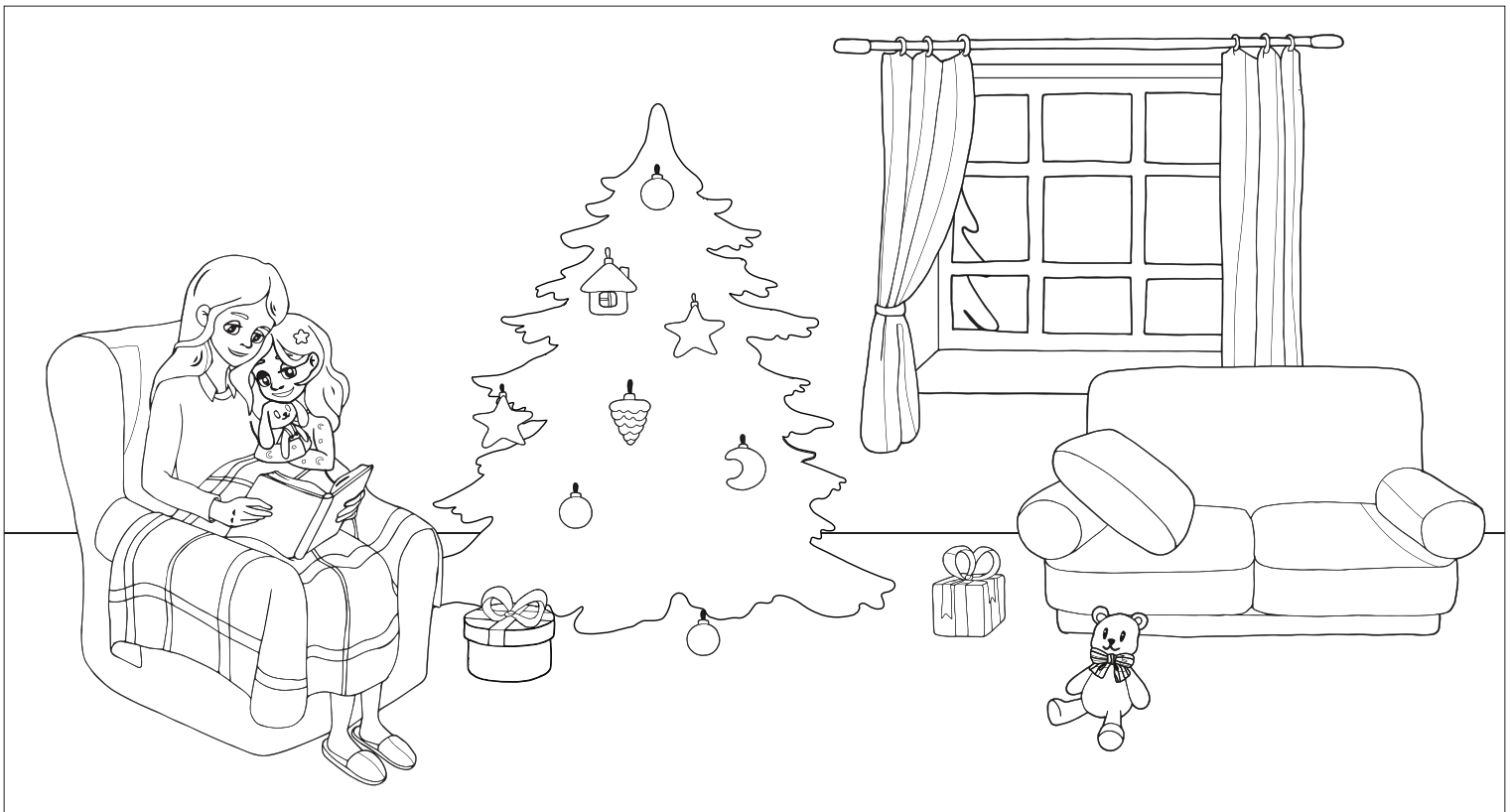
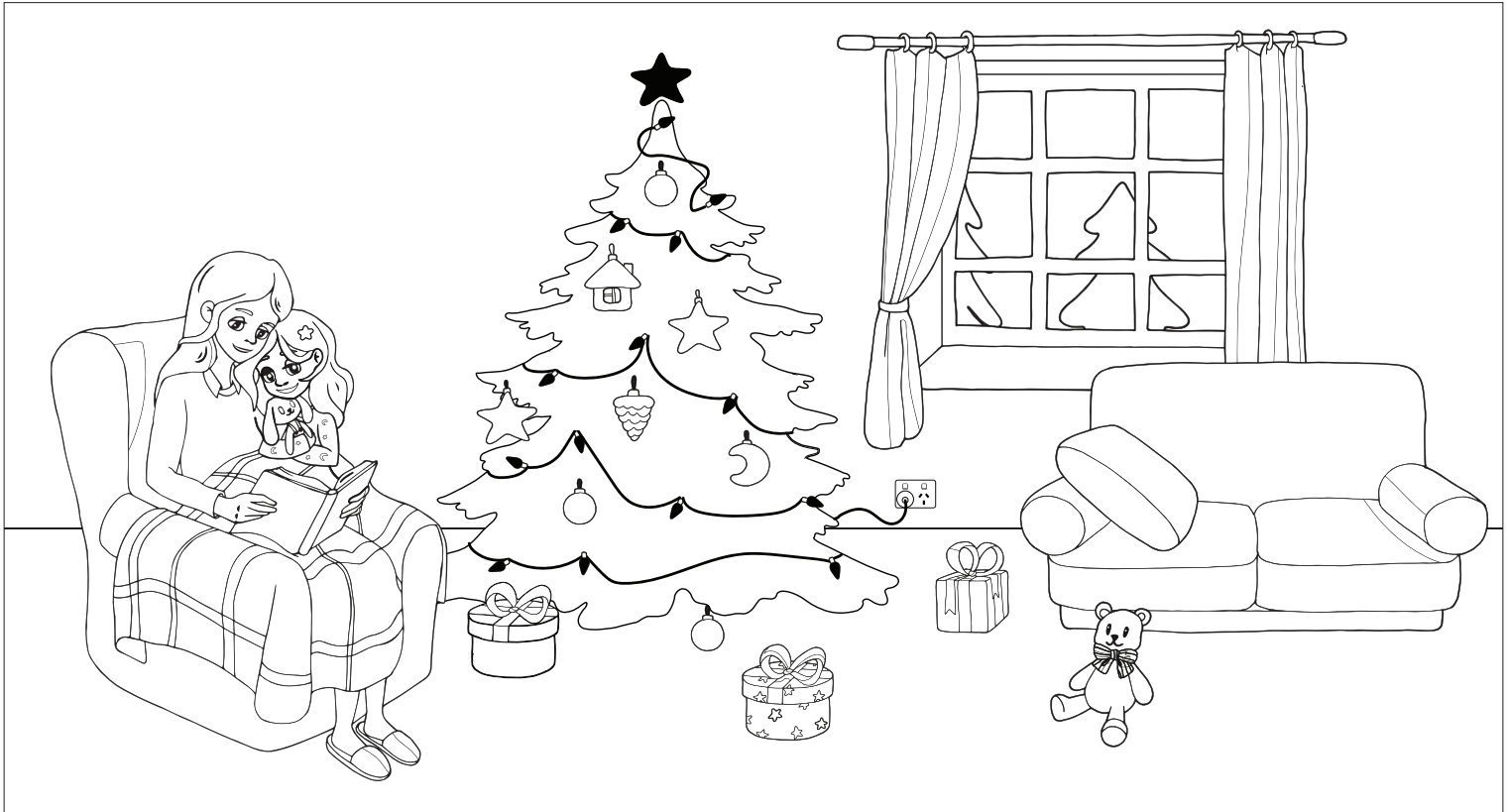
